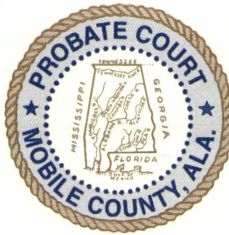

RE: MOBILE COUNTY NEEDS ELECTION POLL WORKERS

The Mobile County Probate Court and other Mobile County officials are actively preparing for the 2024 General Election, which will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Mobile County needs approximately 100 additional poll workers to staff its 80 polls located across Mobile County. These are paid positions and paid training is provided. The training sessions are about to start, so these positions need to be filled as quickly as possible.

The qualifications to serve as an election poll worker are:

- ◆ Be 19 years or older in age
- ◆ Reside in Mobile County
- ◆ Be registered to vote in Mobile County
- ◆ Be able to read and write
- ◆ Have basic understanding of how to operate an "I-phone" or "smart phone"
- ◆ Available to report to the election poll at 6:00 a.m. and remain until poll closes (typically around 8:30 p.m.)
- ◆ Possesses "people skills" - ability to interact with members of the public
- ◆ Be able to complete training via Internet or at Court's offices no later than October 6, 2024
- ◆ Be able to attend a "hands-on" training class regarding the election equipment between October 17, 2024 and October 25, 2024
