RE: CHANGE IN DEADLINE DATE FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS TO BE RETURNED TO THE ABSENTEE ELECTION MANAGER'S OFFICE

DATE: JUNE 3, 2022

On June 2, 2022, the Court issued a press release relating to absentee voting in the upcoming Alabama Primary Runoff Election. Earlier today the Court was informed that Alabama Governor Kay Ivey has declared June 20, 2022 to be a state holiday. The Alabama Secretary of State's Office has advised that because June 20, 2022 is now a state holiday, the deadline date for absentee ballot voters to hand deliver their absentee ballots to the Absentee Election Manager's Office has been changed to Friday, June 17, 2022 at 5:00 o'clock p.m.

If absentee ballots are returned via the United States Postal Service or private courier service, said ballots must be received by the Absentee Election Manager on or before 12:00 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, June 21, 2022.

Likewise, if a voter has a documented, last-minute business emergency to arise, the deadline for the voter to obtain a business emergency absentee ballot has changed from June 20, 2022 to June 17, 2022.

Please note these changes to your audiences on a variety of occasions between now and June 17, 2022.
