Judge Don Davis, Mobile County's Judge of Probate and Chief Election Officer, announced that there have been 5 recent poll location changes. These are:

Precinct # 2 (formerly Belsaw School) - new poll location is Pine Grove Missionary Baptist Church, 19130 Pine Grove Rd., Mt. Vernon, AL

Precinct # 6 (formerly Creola Assembly of God) - new poll location is Creola Senior Center, 9618 Old Hwy 43, Creola, AL

Precinct # 44 (formerly Gracepointe Mobile)- new poll location is Rise Church, 6363 Picadilly Square Dr., Mobile, AL

Precinct # 59 (formerly Cottage Hill Baptist Church) - new poll location is Kate Shepard Elementary School, 3980 Burma Rd., Mobile, AL 36693

Precinct # 69 (formerly Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church) - new poll location is BC Rain High School, 3125 Dauphin Island Pkwy., Mobile, AL 36605

Postcards will be sent to all active, registered voters in Mobile County in late January 2024. These cards will inform voters where they should vote in the upcoming election and provide other important information.

Judge Davis also noted that current voter/election information is available on the Mobile County Probate Court's Internet web site and on FaceBook. The additional information includes:

- Precinct maps for Mobile County
- List of Polls and their locations
- Sample Ballot for the March 5, 2024 Presidential Preference and Statewide Primary Election
- Voter registration information
- Absentee ballot information.

Alabama law requires citizens to vote at the poll of the precinct where they currently live. It is an election crime for a citizen to knowingly vote at the incorrect poll. Any Mobile County citizen who has moved to a new location should immediately update their registration information to ensure they will encounter no delay if they participate in the upcoming election.

All Mobile County citizens can now verify on the Internet that they are registered to vote and their assigned poll. Judge Davis said that the information was being made available on the web site and by FaceBook "as a part of Mobile County's and his office's goal of insuring that every registered Mobile County voter knows what district they reside in, who they may vote for, and where they vote."
