EVERY VOTE COUNTS INFORMATIONAL POSTCARD

On October 1, 2024, Mobile County Probate Court, in partnership with the Mobile County Board of Registrars, mailed 264,620 informational postcards to registered, *active* voters in Mobile County.

Postcards were NOT sent to *inactive* voters. An inactive voter is a registered voter who has not voted in two (2) election cycles (four (4) years).

A citizen may confirm their current active or inactive status by visiting Mobile County Probate Court's website: <a href="www.probate.mobilecountyal.gov">www.probate.mobilecountyal.gov</a> with links to the Alabama Secretary of State website: <a href="www.alabamavotes.gov">www.alabamavotes.gov</a>. A voter may also contact the Mobile County Board of Registrars at 251-574-8586.

If a citizen confirms that they are currently in inactive status, they may reactivate their registration electronically via <a href="www.alabamavotes.gov">www.alabamavotes.gov</a>; mailing in a voter registration update form or going in person to the Board of Registrars' Office at 151 Government Street. At this date, it is recommended that voters handle matters related to voter registration online or in person if possible. The deadline date for such action is Monday, October 21, 2024.
