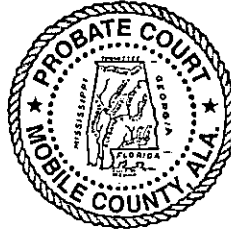

RE: Mobile County Personnel Board Merit System Elections – Merit System Employee Representative, Professional Fire Fighter, and Professional Law Enforcement Officer

A meeting to receive nominations to fill the representative positions of the Supervisory Committee of the Mobile County Personnel Board will be held on Tuesday, August 30th, 2022 from 12 o'clock until 1 o'clock p.m. in Probate Court Room No. 1, Third Floor, Mobile County Government Center Annex, 151 Government Street, Mobile AL.

Nominations for the positions listed above shall be made with an appropriate second at said meeting. Only permanent, full-time employees who are qualified electors and residents of Mobile County as of the date of the meeting may be nominated. If more than one person is duly nominated for any or all representative positions, election ballots will be mailed to each employee group eligible to vote as of the date of the meeting. Eligible employees entitled to vote are permanent, full-time employees in each representative class as of August 30th, 2022. Voted ballots with certifications must be received by the Judge of Probate by 5 o'clock p.m. on Monday, September 19th, 2022. Actual delivery of any ballot must occur by the deadline date and time by hand-delivery or by mail. On Tuesday, September 20th, 2022, the meeting shall reconvene at 3:30 o'clock p.m. in Probate Court Room No. 1 at the location noted above for the inspection of all returned ballot certifications and for the canvassing of the ballots accepted.

Should a run-off for any position become necessary, run-off ballots will be mailed to each eligible employee in the appropriate representative class. Run-off ballots must be received by the Judge of Probate by 5 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, October 11th, 2022. Actual delivery of any ballot must occur by the deadline date and time by hand-delivery or by mail. The run-off certification and canvass meeting will convene on Wednesday, October 12th, 2022 at 3:30 o'clock p.m. in Probate Court Room No. 1 at the location noted herein.
